Start where the operation stops.

Operational problems become expensive when every team owns a fragment and nobody owns the decision. The first job is to define the pressure without prematurely prescribing a system.

Decision

What decision is currently delayed, repeated or made without trusted evidence?

02

Owner

Who must be able to act, approve and explain the result after handover?

03

Boundary

Which process, entities, currencies, dates and systems are in scope?

04

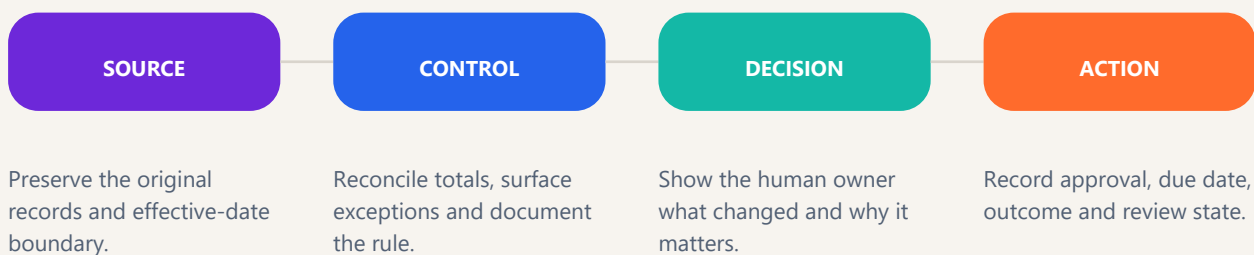
Evidence

Which totals, exceptions and source records must reconcile before action?

A useful first scope is not: fix finance. It is: reconcile one dated EUR receivables view and make the next collection decision explainable.

The control layer connects truth to action.

The answer is often not a new core system. It is a bounded working layer that reconciles existing sources, exposes exceptions and makes ownership visible.



Acceptance test

Can a new operator trace the number, understand the exception, identify the approver and reproduce the next action without the builder in the room?

If not, the layer is still a prototype or a dependency, not an embedded operating control.

Every phase should earn the next one.

A controlled engagement reduces commitment risk. Scope, evidence and adoption decide whether to continue, reshape or stop.

0-10 DAYS

DIAGNOSE

Reconcile the smallest useful baseline. Map sources, controls, ownership and exceptions.

DAY 30

BUILD

Deliver one working control, workflow, dashboard or software layer with acceptance evidence.

DAY 90

EMBED

Scale only what has an owner, operating rhythm, recovery path and demonstrated adoption.
